



JANUARY 2021 – JANUARY 2022 SACRAMENTO CITY AND COUNTY HOMELESS TIMELINE

A year of slow implementation of homeless plan by city; County not engaged on homeless issues; broken promises; continued criminalization of people experiencing homeless; A record 195 deaths of people experiencing homeless – or 1 homeless death every 2 days in Sacramento County

FEBRUARY 2022

AFTER A YEAR:

- Just a few sites out of 20 sites operational
- No City/County agreement
- No Respite Centers
- No Ombudsman program
- No Community Stakeholder Implementation Committee
- As of 1/19/2022- 425 people have exited Project Room Key to permanent housing – since 4/2020 – or about 22 per month over 20 month period
- Hundreds of cars and RV's cited for illegal parking – 274 from 1/3/22 – 1/9/22 and 33 towed in that same period
- From 1/1/21 – 11/30/21 County PARK Rangers cleared 1,552 homeless camps and issued 530 citations to homeless people for littering; shopping cart in park and tying a rope to a tree to keep tent up
- As of 1/20/22 – 2,354 vaccine doses administered
- From 2002- 2021 1,500 people experiencing homelessness have died in Sacramento County
